### Guidelines for Full Paper Submissions

Contributors are invited to follow the below instructions when drafting manuscripts for DJIRC-2022

#### A. Preliminary Instructions

Layout	MS Word document with standard margins
Title	Centre-Aligned, Bold, Times New Roman, 14-Point Font, Sentence Case
Subdivisions	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• The main headings should be aligned on the left and numbered I, II, and so on, Times New Roman, 13-point font, bold.</li><li>• Second-level headings should be aligned on the left and lettered A, B, C, and so on, Times New Roman, 13-point font.</li><li>• Third-level headings should be aligned on the left and numbered 1, 2, 3, and so on, Times New Roman, 13-point font.</li></ul>
Text	Times New Roman, 12-point font, justified
Spacing	1.5 spacing
Footnotes	Times New Roman, 10-point font, justified, single spacing.
Paginated	paginated at the bottom right
Referencing	<a href="#">OSCOLA</a>
Language	Papers must be written in English. British English should be used throughout the manuscript.
Word Limit	5000 words excluding footnotes.

#### B. Further Instructions

1. The submission should be an original, unpublished work not currently under consideration for publication elsewhere.
2. The name of the author should appear centred under the title. An asterisked footnote should designate the author's position, institutional address, and brief acknowledgements if any.
3. Articles should be accompanied by the short abstract.
4. Footnoting should not be excessive.
5. All abbreviations should be spelt out first, with the abbreviation following in brackets.
6. Use "per cent" rather than the symbol %.
7. The word "Article" should be capitalised, e.g., Article and Art.
8. Phrases other than the English language should be italicised.
9. Please ensure you have read and complied with the submission guidelines before submitting your manuscript.
